Dear Readers,

In this bulletin, you are provided with up-to-date information on the different activities we have carried out within the framework of the Erasmus+ Project for Increasing of Vocational Competencies of Commercial Vehicle Drivers (VOC of DRIVERS/2019-1-TR01-KA202-074813).

"Increasing of Vocational Competences of Commercial Vehicle Drivers" titled Project and numbered 2019-1-TR01-KA202-074813 submitted during the 2019 Call for Proposals within the scope of the EU Erasmus+ Program Strategic Partnerships for Vocational Training (KA202) activity by the Turkish Federation of Commercial Drivers and Vehicle Owners(short name VOCOFDRIVERS Project) was implemented through 01 December 2019-31 May 2022 and was successfully completed.

The partners of the project are the Turkish Federation of Commercial Drivers and Vehicle Ownersfrom our country, the General Directorate of Private Education Institutions of the Ministry of National Education, the Federation of All Education Associations (TÜMEDEF), together with the Training 2000 PSC (vocational training centre) and CNA AssociazioneProvinciale di Pesaro e Urbino (professional organization) from Italy, PONS Seguridad Vial (road safety firm) from Spain and IBF (Driver (SRC) training centre) from Germany. The associate of the project, SUPSI (University of Applied Sciences of Southern Switzerland), is a technology university established in Switzerland.

The project is directly related to the vocational training and qualification certification of drivers in the transportation sector, and they contributed to the emergence of a successful project by bringing their knowledge and experience together.

The idea of the project arose from the need to identify the practices in the EU countries on passenger transportation, to identify innovative methods and techniques in driver training, and to support the adaptation of drivers and people and organizations interested in driver training to the rapidly digitalizing world. With this idea, the aim of the Project is to ensure that drivers employed in the road transport sector have transferable professional knowledge, skills and competencies by using digital technologies in their training and exams, and to strengthen the international working capacities and communication networks of vocational education/training providers and other social parties in this sector.

Project studies for all outputs and activities of the project were carried out in 5 different countries. Despite the disruptions in the execution of some project activities due to the Corona Pandemic (Covid-19), which affected the whole world in 2019 and 2020, the project works were carried out as uninterrupted as possible. However, an extension of 6 months was















requested to compensate for the problems experienced, and the project was completed in two and a half years.

During this process, online meetings were held with the partners and the project progress and project studies continued at every stage. Online project meetings and conversations are held with project partners. Accordingly, 10 online (via Skype application) meetings and 5 face-to-face transnational project meetings were held with the participation of all partners during the entire project process.

During the face-to-face transnational project meetings, educational institutions operating in the field of driver training were visited as an additional activity; Information about the training, examination and certification processes for drivers was obtained.



With the promotion and dissemination of the project (with the project website-(https://vocofdrivers.tsof.org.tr), facebook account (vocofdrivers), project brochure, news bulletins, information meetings held in each partner country, etc.) monitoring studies of the project quality (with tools such as interim and final reports, internal progress reports, surveys and feedback forms, etc.) were carried out.

The intellectual outputs envisaged and realized in the project are briefly summarized below. It is possible to reach the mentioned outputs from the project website (web). The project website has been prepared in English and in the languages of the project partner countries (Turkish, German, Italian and Spanish), and it is possible to reach these outputs in 5 languages.

Project Outputs

1st Intellectual Output – Current situation and profile analysis: A research report has been prepared that includes topics such as the legislation, occupational standards and qualifications, training, exams and certifications, the role of e-learning and digital materials in their education, employment status, and expectations from education of drivers engaged in passenger transport (especially urban passenger transport) in partner countries.



• 4th Intellectual Output – Testing of the training program: The training program and e-materials created were tested on the drivers and their trainers engaged in urban passenger transport in the partner countries, and then national and joint pilot training evaluation reports were prepared. The project outputs were received very positively by the target groups and were highly appreciated. A Training Plan including all the studies related to the pilot trainings (general information, training methodology, interactive training materials frameworks, testing methodology, evaluation of trainings and the user's guide of the h5p platform used in the development of interactive e training materials) has also been prepared and posted on the website.
